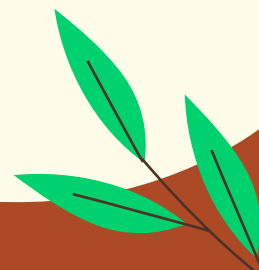

## WHAT TO WEAR

Make sure you dress appropriately for the weather.

We recommend that you wear trainers or similar footwear with good grip, and that you don't mind getting grubby. No open-toed or slip-on shoes permitted.

Long hair has to be tied back, body piercings removed or taped over, leg wear should be knee length, and tops cover the waist as the participants will be wearing a harness.

Some people like to wear gloves, especially if it's cold. You can purchase these on the day for £4.

## ARRIVING ON TIME AND FINDING US

We're a very accommodating team at Wild Pines, and will therefore do our best to rearrange your day as needed. Please call or email as soon as possible so that we can make

appropriate amendments to the itinerary if required.

Arriving early gives your school enough time to check in and meet the team, drop bags off and head to the loo before your adventure begins without any stress.

## DURING YOUR VISIT

A member of the team will greet you when you arrive. We will then show you where our woodland room is, along with the cabin and classroom where pupils can put their belongings safely away.

Please note there are changing facilities on site, along with proper flushing toilets inside our main brick building.

The team will take good care of you all throughout your amazing day!

## HOW TO UTILISE YOUR SCHOOL TRIP



### POST-TRIP ACTIVITIES

We encourage active learning both before and after a trip to Wild Pines Park. This helps to encourage development within the class and increase the value of the trip. You can do this in many ways, however here are a few suggestions:

## HOW SAFE IS IT?

Wild Pines Park has an exceptional safety record and exceeds all of the European safety standards (EN 15567 parts 1 and 2).

Every group is different (age, ability, number etc), but as a rough guide.

## CAN I JUST WATCH?

Yes of course you can, spectators are more than welcome.

## DO YOU PROVIDE GIFT BAGS?

Yes, on request. Just email before the day and we can arrange these for you, they are priced at £6 each and contain an impressive array of merchandise hand made by the Wild Pines Park Team.

## DISABLED ACCESS

We have full disabled access toilets that are cleaned everyday. These are on site, in a brick building, 100m away from the main activities.

# SUPERVISION RATIOS

Schools should adhere to their own School Trip policy for specific ratios of staff to students.

Our dedicated staff are able to monitor, assist and rescue all students whilst on the ropes course. We recommend that school staff take part wherever possible, providing support to those who will need it most.

We do require that a member of school staff be present on the ground during the tree top activities.


For Archery and Mini Golf, a member of school staff must be present.

Treasure hunts are instructed at the start by a member of staff, the pupils are then left to discover the treasure by themselves. A member of staff must supervise them whilst undertaking this activity.
